

7th WINES OF CHILE AWARDS:

Cono Sur, the most awarded winery of the contest, won the first place on Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Viognier

The 7th version of the "Wines of Chile Awards", the most important and prestigious Chilean wine event, awarded Cono Sur with three trophies, from a total of 13 accolades.

The categories and wines that were honored are as follows:

Trophy Best "Other white wines": Cono Sur Vision Viognier 2009

Trophy Best Chardonnay: Cono Sur 20 Barrels Limited Edition Chardonnay 2008

Trophy Best Pinot Noir: Cono Sur 20 Barrels Limited Edition Pinot Noir 2008

For the first time, the event had Canadian judges, composed by 10 of the most important wine writers and columnists of that country: Anthony Gismondi, Tony Aspler, Nick Hamilton, David Lawrason, Rod Phillips, John Szabo, Gurvinder Bhatia, Sid Cross, David Scholefield y Bill Zacharkiw.

Nearly 500 wines from 111 Chilean wineries were tasted and judged by variety and sale price.
