Tablas Creek Vineyard, Paso Robles (California) Grenache 2007 (\$35): Light and remarkably nimble for a California Grenache weighing in with 15.3% alcohol, this is a surprisingly fresh wine that offers a lot of flavor and fun. It shows red cherry notes on both nose and palate that are lightly sweet but balanced by subtle spice accents and fine-grained tannins. There's also some fresh acidity to lift and focus the finish.
