Pazo de Senorans is owned by Marisol Bueno, one of the pioneers of this young appellation. Through her work, the DO was created in 1988, quality thresholds were introduced, and the region began to receive wider worldwide recognition. Today, the property is one of the few remaining family owned estates, and remains quite small in order to maintain a rigorous level of quality.

Light gold-colored, it delivers an attractive nose of mineral, white peach, and lemon zest. Smooth textured on the palate, tropical flavors emerge along with lively acidity. This lengthy Albarino will drink well for another three years.”

“Green-tinged yellow. Powerful scents of white peach, yellow plum and mango, with a racy streak of minerals adding vivacity. Pure, focused and tangy, offering fresh lemon, orange and pit fruit flavors and a musky floral quality. Very deep but refreshing, with a penetrating note of talc-y minerals on the extremely long, brisk finish. This will be very flexible with food.”
