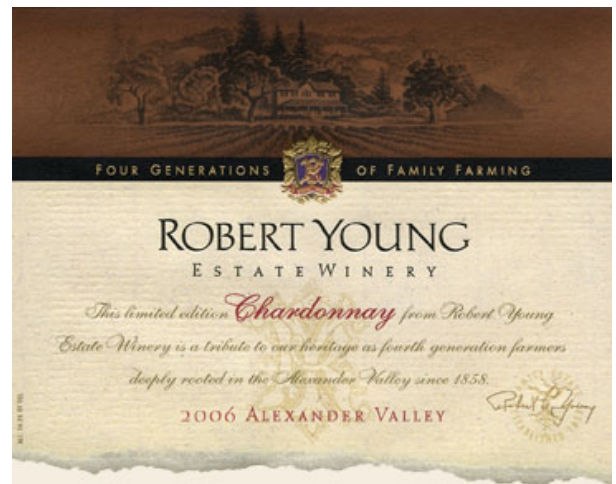




2006 ALEXANDER VALLEY ESTATE CHARDONNAY

The 2006 Robert Young Estate Alexander Valley Chardonnay has rich aromas of sweet red apple, pineapple, and tropical fruits, typically produced by our Robert Young Chardonnay clone. But this 2006 Chardonnay has more. It is spicy, has a zest of lemon and cream and a little vanilla. The body of the wine is near perfect. It has weight, but at the same time is silky and light. The wine has balance. It coats the mouth in a most pleasing way, lingers, and then leaves you with its memory in a subtle way.
